

The icons are an important part of the Women and Sport Timeline; they add colour and enhance engagement. The icons were purchased from [FlatIcon](#) in 2017.

As of summer 2018, there are 52 icons used to depict Timeline entries from an array of sports and physical activity.

There are also twelve further icons to demonstrate activism for women and sport that has not been in the form of sporting participation. These are explained below:



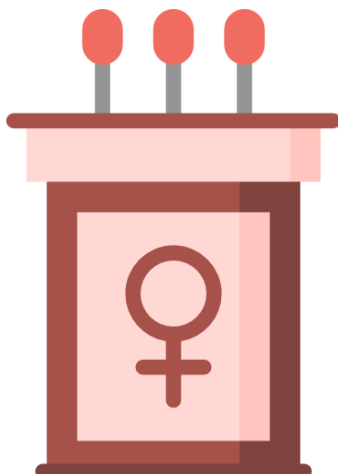
### **Non-sport**

This icon signifies major non-sporting events. The events have probably impacted upon sport in some way, whether that be globally or nationally. The icon demonstrates a newsworthy event.



### **Organisation**

This icon denotes when an organisation has been founded or a Timeline entry dedicated solely to the organisation. The icon demonstrates working together.



### **Women's committee**

This icon refers to when a women's agency group, committee, commission or board has been formed within an existing organisation. The icon demonstrates a platform for women's voices to be heard.



### **Representation**

This icon highlights a range of 'firsts' for women and is often used when women are first represented within an organisation or a sport. The icon demonstrates women's activism.



### **Conference**

This icon shows a key form of activism for women in sport. Conferences have been used to raise consciousness and launch organisations and key statutes to advance women and sport. The icon demonstrates a woman talking at a conference.



### **Networking**

This icon conveys when groups of individuals or organisations have undertaken networking separately to conferences, events and meetings. The icon demonstrates working together because of multiple people around a cog.



### Meeting

This icon stands for when individuals and organisations have hosted meetings. Often, these are for the purpose of their own organisation. The icon demonstrates conversation.



### Event

This icon represents the range of seminars, workshops, forums and symposiums to have been undertaken for women and sport. The icon demonstrates work via women and turning cogs.



### Programme

This icon implies when a project, programme, festival, activity day or campaign has been launched and/or undertaken. The icon demonstrates a calendar in the colours of the IWG Botswanan Secretariat (2014-2018).



### **Publication**

This icon indicates when knowledge has been shared, usually via a report, research or paper media (magazines). The icon demonstrates an organisational document.



### **Key document**

This icon symbolises when law, legislation, resolutions or policy have been enacted. The icon demonstrates a scripted document of significance.



### **Media**

This icon expresses when the media (television, radio, online, print) have directly interacted with women and sport in some form. The icon demonstrates the most popular form of media.
